Your Childs Attendance Matters act now to prevent future educational implications.

Term Time Leave of Absence

Leave of absence during term time will not be authorised unless there is an exceptional circumstance. If, for any reason, you do require a leave of absence, please contact the school office to request and complete the required form.

Once received this will go to the headteachers to review. If you take your child out of school and the absence is not agreed by the head teacher, this will be recorded as unauthorised absence. We will then notify Hereford Council and you may face a Fixed Penalty Notice and/or other legal action. Local Authority regulations state that leave of absence applications should be made at least 4 weeks prior to the leave taking place, and, if it is for a holiday, ideally before the holiday is booked.

Impact by year 10 of poor attendance.

Of pupils who miss more than 50% of school, only 3% manage to achieve five A* to Cs, including English and maths. Pupils who miss between 10% and 20% of school, only 35% manage to achieve five A* to C GCSEs, including English and maths pupils who miss less than 5% of school, 73% achieve 5 A* to Cs, including English and maths.

<u>Absences</u> Parents/carer are required to contact the school before **9.30am** on the first day of their child's absence with full details of the reason their child is absent and each subsequent day of absence, in person, by letter, by email, by phone or by Parentmail. Any notification after **9.30am** will be marked as unauthorised. (0)

<u>Late Arrival</u> Please ensure your child is in school at the correct time before Registration ends. Arrivals after these times will be recorded as late (L) till 9.15am. Arrivals after 9.15am will be recorded as unauthorised (U) in line with our attendance policy
