CHARGING AND REMISSIONS POLICY

GENERAL



All pupils are entitled to free education; this includes materials, and equipment during school hours. In accordance with DFE and Local Authority guidelines there will be no charge for any activities that are an essential part of the National Curriculum.

CHARGING

The School will charge for:

- 1. Trips out of school hours;
- 2. The cost of replacing damaged equipment or lost education resources or for repairing damage to the fabric of the school building where this is a result of their child's bad or irresponsible behaviour
- 3. For activities during the school day such as outings to museums and places of interest contributions will be sought from parents/carers.
- 4. Parents will be asked to contribute to the cost of swimming lessons.
- 5. Breakfast club
- 6. Lunch time nursery club
- 7. Additional nursery hours that are not NEF funded
- 8. Music tuition(Individual or small groups)
- 9. Board and lodging costs on a residential trip (unless parents are exempt by proving they are receiving the following benefits.
 - Universal credit in prescribed circumstances
 - Income Support
 - Income based Jobseekers Allowance
 - Support under the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
 - Child tax Credit, providing the Working Tax Credit is not also received and the family's income does not exceed £16,190
 - The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
 - An income related employment and support allowance that was brought in on 27 October 2008

REMISSIONS

Where contributions are sought, failure to contribute will not exclude a pupil from a particular activity.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Any child who is entitled to free school meals is eligible for a subsidy, if requested; this will be communicated to parents.
