Year 2 Farm Day – Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October

In our topic sessions this term we have been learning about 'What farming was like in the past' focusing on how life has changed within living memory.

In order to further enhance the children's learning in this area, we will be holding a 'farm day' in school on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October. As part of the day, the children will explore traditional methods for making products such as butter and bread and learn to 'milk' a cow.

We hope that this will be a fun day for the children and help to bring their learning to life! We would really like the children to dress up in 'farm' clothes – jeans, shirts, overalls – to help them to really become involved in the day.

Year 2 visit to Leominster museum – Friday 19<sup>th</sup> October

Following our farm day, we have planned a visit to Leominster museum where the children will be able to learn about what it was like to be a farmer in the past. They will also have the opportunity to explore farming machinery and the traditional methods used on farms. We will be visiting the museum on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> October.

Children will need to wear a waterproof, warm coat, their school uniform and sensible shoes. If your child requires an inhaler please ensure it is in school and in date. We will not be able to take your child on the trip if they are asthmatic and do not have an in date inhaler.
