Dear parents,

If you wish to speak to your teacher at the end of the day, can we please ask you to wait until the teacher has seen out all the children and then they can be free to talk to you. Please can we also ask for pushchairs to not enter the classroom.

Organisation

The children are trying really hard with organising their belongings in school. It would be really helpful if you could regularly check all your child's uniform / PE kit / lunchbox / book bag is clearly named. It is the only way that we can know who it belongs to. The children spend time learning outside too and have wonderful activities prepared for them. Please ensure your child is always dressed appropriately for all weather situations.

Please ensure your child has their PE bag. Any forms or letters should be put in their book bags and we check their bags daily. We do recommend that your child has a purple school book bag, to ensure all letters get home to parents. Your child will need their book bag every day.

Our Learning

We will be planning from the children's interests throughout the year. This term our topics are Autumn / Harvest and Ourselves. The children will be exploring all areas of learning through this topic. At this stage of the year our priority is getting to know the children well so we can plan activities and they will enjoy learning. Every Friday your teacher will set up a class challenge. This will be displayed on the classroom window next to the letters and numbers of the week. Can the challenge please be completed by the following week.

Individual Profiles

Each child will soon have an online individual profile on Tapestry. Hopefully you came to our induction evening last July and saw the benefits of the profile. It is a fantastic way to view your child's school life and achievements. As a parent / carer, you are aware of your child's interests and strengths. We would like to include your contributions in their profiles and so we welcome any photographs, certificates, wow moments or comments. If you have signed up for this, you will soon receive an email to activate your account. Please see below, dates for your diary at the end of this newsletter, inviting you to attend a drop in tapestry information session.

Phonics / Reading

We use the Read Write Inc programme to teach reading. The children will be learning to say, blend and remember sounds. These skills are building blocks to reading. You will be invited in this term to our Phonics workshop for parents so that you can learn how we teach phonics and how you can support your child at home. Reading scheme books will follow later, when your child is ready to use their new skills to begin reading some phrases and sentences. Until then, enjoy sharing our bedtime books. Please look at 'How to support your child with reading' which was given at your home visit. During the term, we will also be inviting you along to 'story time'.

Session times

Our doors open at 8:45 am so that our school day starts promptly at 8.50am. School finishes at 3.15pm. We would like to remind you of the importance of attendance and punctuality and ask that you make every effort to bring your child to school every day and collect them on time. If you are late in the morning you will need to go to the front desk at Reception where the admin staff will see you. Please telephone the school in the morning if your child is going to be absent from school. Please Telephone **01568616919**.

Please can I kindly remind you that when you are waiting for the school doors to open, stand behind the pencils and the sheltered area. Can children not play with the toys under the shelter because the area is often set up for the day.

Meeting with your Teacher

If you need to talk to the class teacher, they are available at the end of each day. Sometimes they may not be able to talk as they have other commitments after school, but you can always make an appointment.
