Out of 22 classes we had **5** on target over **96%**, **12** Above **90%** and **5** below **90%**

Herefordshire Schools' attendance is 94.1%. This is above the national average of 93.7%. Our YTD attendance is a concern as we are below both of these at **92.7%**.

We continue to work with all parents to ensure that children are in school as it is important for their achievement, wellbeing, and wider development.

Persistent Absence

Parents or carers have responsibility for ensuring their child receives appropriate full-time education, whether that is in school or otherwise. When a child is registered at school, you as the parent or carer are responsible for ensuring your child attends regularly. Failure to do so may lead to a referral being made to Herefordshire Council. This could result in a fixed penalty notice or further legal action including a maximum fine of £2,500 and/or up to three months imprisonment

We currently have over 150 Persistent absent children. At this level the child's educational development and well-being are affected. Referrals are now being made to the local authority and fines are in the process of being issued.

Polite reminders

We are seeing an increase in absences not being reported to school. Can we please remind parents/carers that you are required to contact the school before **9.30am** on the first day of your child's absence with full details of the reason your child is absent and each subsequent day of absence, in person, by letter, by email, by phone or by Parentmail.
