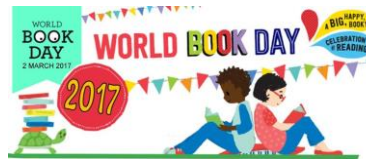

Dear Parents/Carers,

On **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March**, schools across the country will be celebrating World Book Day. On this day, we will be joining in by asking the children to come to school dressed as character from a book they have read and enjoyed. If you are struggling for ideas/costumes, there are many simple and low-effort options such as 'Where's Wally', 'Burglar Bill', characters from Roald Dahl's books, Dennis the Menace, Harry Potter, Harry from 'Harry and his Bucket Full of Dinosaurs', Paddington Bear, characters from Room on the Broom, Mr Men and Little Miss characters and 101 Dalmatians. The list is endless! Each class will be celebrating in their own way but it promises to be an exciting and entertaining day.

Further to this, the two book clubs in school are going to work together to set up a 'Book Swap'. We are asking children to bring in books from home which they have finished reading and would like to swap for a different title. Additionally, the Book Fair will be visiting school and will be bringing hundreds of new children's books to browse and buy.
