Curriculum and Topic:

Computing: Accessing the computer

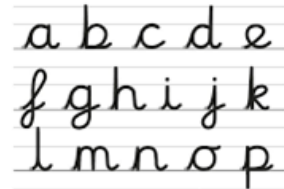
Homework

Reading is extremely important. It is vital that you listen to your child read and ask them questions about what they have read. Please read with your child as often as possible. Children also love to hear others read too, helping them to become expressive, fluent readers. Routines of having a bedtime story is a lovely way to support this. Fluency is a key aspect of our reading!



By the end of the year, there are **common exception words** which the children are expected to be able to read and spell accurately. These are available on the school website for you to practise with your child. Children will take a Phonics Screening test in the Summer term. In phonics lessons we encourage children to underline any 'special friends' they may find.

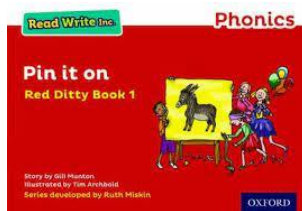
The children will now be taught how to start **joining their letters** when writing. In Year 1 we call this pre-cursive. You could encourage your child to practise this at home. This could be with pencil to paper, with paints or even in messy play!



Topic – Research Victorians with a family member and discuss materials of toys you have at home.

Reading

We are continually assessing your child's reading and phonic knowledge.



Children should be bringing their book bag to school every day.

The books will be changed regularly (according to their phonic group) – Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Please read as often as possible with your children.

Physical Education (P.E.)

Please ensure your children bring in their labelled PE kits at the start of each half term. We will send their kit home at the end of each half term to be washed.



Earrings are required to be taken out or covered over with tape on PE days.

PE days change each half term. Each Year 1 class will have their PE day poster in their window.
