### English

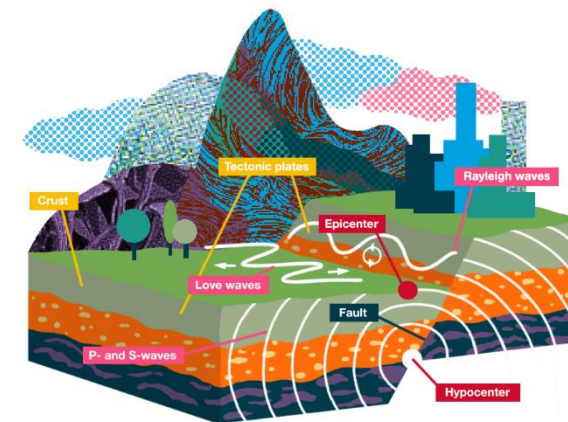
